Private companies or non-profit organizations are also eligible for grants under the Competitive Plan Implementation grant program.

Fiscal Year 2003 Grant Programs

Deadline Dates

Round #11 Competitive Plan Implementation Grants

April 26, 2002

Provides funding for the development and operation of recycling, source reduction, waste minimization and solid waste management public education programs.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Grants

May 17, 2002

Provides funding to assist in the safe disposal of HHW, public education, and the development of local household hazardous waste programs.

\*August 16, 2002
\*December 13, 2002

Small Quantity Hazardous Waste Generator (SQG) Grants

May 17, 2002

Provides funding to develop and implement small quantity hazardous waste generator programs.

\*August 16, 2002
\*December 13, 2002

\* Subject to availability of funds.

The anticipated date of award for the Competitive Plan Implementation grant is July 2002. All other grants are awarded within six weeks of the deadline date.
